

Eligibility For AJIVASAN Gurukul Accommodation

- Ajivasan can provide Gurukul facility to 8 Students (4 Rooms). Each room is either shared by two boys or two girls.
- Gurukul facility will be provided for a minimum tenure of 12 months and a maximum tenure of 36 months, depending on the yearly renewal approved by the Gurukul management.
- Students should have a minimum qualification of SSC/ HSC pass.
- Student should be an outstation resident.
- Minimum age of an applicant should be 16 years and above.
- List of original & attested documents required for Gurukul enrolment:
 - a. Birth certificate
 - b. SSC/HSC pass certificate/mark-sheet
 - c. Residence Address proof
 - d. Photo ID proof
 - e. 4 Passport size photographs
 - f. Medical certificate
- Students have to go through three rounds of audition. The first round of audition is an interview, second round of singing audition is taken by our academic teachers. Shri Suresh Wadkarji will take the third & the final round of the audition.
- Once the student passes all the auditions, he/she shall be eligible for getting a Gurukul facility in Ajivasan, depending on the room availability.
- Once enrolled with Ajivasan, the student cannot take any other regular job / training / education from any other institute or academy apart from distance learning institutes.
- The monthly fees of Gurukul will be Rs. 15,000/- per month which will include basic accommodation facility, electricity & water usage, personal training from Sureshji and eligibility to sit in any one academic class of Ajivasan.
- Students will have to make arrangements for their food (Dabba/Tiffin) and Ajivasan does not provide any kitchen or cooking space for students.
- No leave can be granted for the first six months of stay in the Gurukul
- Fees would be taken annually in advance. And shall be Non-refundable. In case the student decides to discontinue before the completion of his tenure of 12 months, no refund is possible.
- In case of any misbehaviour of the student, the Gurukul management may decide to expel any of the Gurukul residents. The Gurukul shall not be liable to refund the remaining fees in such cases.
- Police verification is compulsory/mandatory.
- A medical certificate of an authorised doctor, stating that the candidate is free from any infectious disease, is mandatory before the entrance to Gurukul
- Medical insurance has to be done by the students
